

Champagne

Gosset, Grand Rose 75 cl 65€

40% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir, 10% Pinot Meunier, and another 10% Pinot Noir added as a red wine. This is wonderfully clean with flavours of rose-hip, redcurrant and peach.

Perrier Jouet Blason Rose 75 cl 130€

Pinot Noir 45%, Pinot Meunier 30%, Chardonnay 25%. Delicate aromas of red fruits and rose petals followed by a full bodied palate of raspberries, strawberries and citrus with a fresh finish.

Cuvee Rosee Laurent-Perrier 75 cl 105€

Perrier Jouet, Belle Epoque Millésime 2002, 75 cl 140€

A prestige cuvee with an elegant lightness of fruit and a wonderful creaminess on the finish. Perrier Jouet used to be the champagne of choice to the courts of Napoleon III and Queen Victoria!

Perrier Jouet, Belle Epoque Millésime 2004, 75 cl 120€

Aromas of tropical fruits, white flowers and peach. The palate is both round and elegant, with a silky mouth feel. The Belle Epoque 2004 offers up a harmonious and daintily balanced flavour. A refined champagne with a long finish.



White Wine

Saint Joseph Blanc, Ferraton, Rhône

Millésime 2013, 75 cl. 33.00 €

This is a Marsanne & Roussanne blend from northern Rhône. This wine is elegant and medium bodied. It develops aromas of apricot, honey and acacia.

Chablis La Boissonneuse, Julien Brocard, Bourgogne

Millésime 2014, 75 cl. 36.00 €

This Chablis comes from on of the most famous wine maker of the appellation. This chardonnay combines a great minerality with white flowers and citrus aromas. Good with seafood or as a pre-dinner drink. Organic Wine.

Pouilly-Fuissé, Domaine Bourdon

Millésime 2014, 75 cl. 40.00 €

A classic and classy white burgundy from the southern region of Burgundy: It's a medium to full bodied chardonnay with a great balance between fruit and minerality.

Roussette, Cellier de La Baraterie, Savoie

Millésime 2015, 75 cl. 28.00 €

Probably one of the best white Savoie wines we've ever tasted! It's rounded, opulent and extremely well balanced with a good minerality.

Sancerre La côte des Monts Damnés, Henri Bourgeois

Millésime 2014, 75 cl. 53.00 €

This Sauvignon Blanc comes from one of the best terroir un Chavignol, heart of the Bourgeois Wine Estate. Hence this wine is ample, mineral and fabulously aromatic.

Condrieu Les Mandouls, Ferraton

Millésime 2014, 75 cl. 69.00 €

The best viogniers come from Condrieu. We like the exotic fruit flavours balance by the great minerality.

Puligny-Montachet 1 er Cru, Domaine Chanson

Millésime 2014, 75 cl. 125.00 €

An iconic village and a famous producer. Ever dreamt of trying a top end white wine? This is for you. It's a truly gastronomic wine - yet fantastically balanced and will match white meat, poultry or cheese speciality.

Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru

Millésime 2008, 75 cl. 175.00 €

There are very few Grand Cru Whites in Burgundy, known to produce the best chardonnays in the world. Here is a very fine example of a top end chardonnay: Complex, elegant and charming; It's a rare wine.



Red Wine

Mondeuse Saint Jean la Porte, Cellier de la Baraterie, Savoie

Millésime 2015, 75 cl. 28.00 €

Here is a top end Savoie Red. The Mondeuse grape variety is liked to the Syrah. The Cellier de la Baraterie is owned by a young and talented winemaker who produces a great red, spicy and fruity, a great expression of the south facing terroir of Saint Jean de la Porte.

Bourgogne Hautes Côtes de Nuits Domaine Gros Frères & Sœur

Millésime 2015, 75 cl. 49.00 €

From a vineyard close the famous Vosne-Romanée, this wine offers a great structure with soft tannins and black cherry flavours, from one of the best winemaker in Vosne-Romanée.

Chianti Classico Reserva Berardo, Castello di Bossi

Millésime 2011, 75 cl. 59.00 €

Castello di Bossi is located in the historical region of Chianti (The Chianti Classico). This Riserva is a very fine example of what sangiovese grape can offer: black cherry aromas in a medium to full body red wine with a great elegance.

Chateau Vieux Taillefer, Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux

Millésime 2011, 75 cl. 75.00 €

Soft and mellow, this Bordeaux is based on the Merlot grape with great aromas of red fruit. You need to warm up after a day on the slopes? Try this great Saint Emilion!

Beaune 1er Cru Teurons, Domaine Chanson

Millésime 2011, 75 cl. 75.00 €

The Chanson Wine Estate is located in the fortifications of the medieval town of Beaune. Here we have a premir cru that shows great aromas of red and black fruits in a medium bodied wine with a long finish.

Cote Rotie l'Eglantine, Ferraton, Rhône

Millésime 2013, 75 cl. 92.00 €

A great and complex wine with fruits, leather and truffle flavours!

Ségla Margaux, Bordeaux

Millésime 2009, 75 cl. 105.00 €

Vosne-Romanée, Domaine Georges Noëllat

Millésime 2012, 75 cl. 150.00 €

Vosne produces the best Pinot Noir in the world. Maxime Cheurlin has taken over the family domaine in 2009. 5 years on, his wines are now part of the top league and it's getting incredibly complicated to get a few bottles... Probably the best Pinot Noirs we've ever tried.

Château Pape Clément, Pessac Léognan Grand Cru

Millésime 2009, 75 cl. 225.00 €

One of the very few chateaux in Pessac-Léognan awarded "Grand Cru Classé". An absolute classic full bodied wine from Bordeaux with soft tannins and black fruits aromas.

Grands Echezeaux Grand Cru, Domaine Georges Noëllat

Millésime 2012, 75 cl. 450.00 €

If you've already tried the Vosne-Romanée from this wine estate, it will be hard to resist opening this bottle from the grand cru next to the world famous" Romanée-Conti". We believe it's one of the best pinot noir in the world

Clos Vougeot "Musigni", Domaine Gros Frères & Sœur"

Millésime 2013, 75 cl. 290.00 €

Not Only a Grand Cru Clos Vougeot, this wine is from the top part of the Clos Vougeot which explains why the mention "Musigni" is on the bottle. Here you have the concentrated aromas only top Pinot Noirs can give.
